Chairman Mere announces:

- Rollback Rate 3.1854
- Proposed Millage Rate 3.5000 Mills
- Percentage increase in millage over RBR is 9.88% over the Rolled Back Rate

Chairman Mere states the reason the ad valorem revenues are being increased:

 The Ad Valorem revenues are increased due to an increase in property values and growth within the District

Chairman Mere calls for Public Input on the Tentative Millage Rate
